



NEW YORK INTERNATIONAL FRINGE FESTIVAL CODE

SIDE LETTER TO THE NYC BASIC SHOWCASE CODE

The New York International Fringe Festival Code shall be in effect for the 2010 Festival. All individual Festival producers shall be required to follow the Basic Showcase Code guidelines, amended by this side letter, and apply for approval of their production to participate in the New York International Fringe Festival. The Basic Showcase Code and side letter are not available for use by any Equity contract producer.

Rule 1, BASIC SHOWCASE CODE: QUALIFICATIONS & LIMITATIONS:

- *Venues for the New York International Fringe Festival productions shall be limited to 500 seats and shall be contained in lower Manhattan below 14th Street*

Rule 4(C), GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- *There shall be no televising, broadcasting, visual and/or sound recording, cast album recording, motion picture filming, videotaping or other mechanical or electronic reproduction, in whole or in part, of any Code production. This prohibition shall be in effect from the first day of rehearsal under the Code until 26 weeks after the production has closed. The only one time exception to this rule shall be for a New York International Fringe Festival Press Conference. Such filming or taping at this Press Conference shall not exceed fifteen (15) minutes and no more than two (2) minutes of any filmed or taped portion of a performance or rehearsal shall be shown on TV news broadcast or community affairs program. The edited footage shown shall not depict an entire scene or musical number*

Rule 4(D), GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- *Material which is suitable for Theatre for Young Audiences may be performed in the New York International Fringe Festival under this Code as part of the FringeJR programming.*

Rule 4(G), GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- *At the discretion of Actors' Equity Association, a New York International Fringe Festival production may be extended beyond the Festival time period for any remaining performances up to 16, as long as it is within 8 weeks after the Fringe Festival is over. Extensions will only be permitted in Showcase approved venues, up to 99 seats*

Rule 13(C), PRESENTATION CONDITIONS:

- *Each Equity member participating in a New York International Fringe Festival Showcase production shall receive a stipend of at least \$350, which includes travel reimbursement*

I have read and will abide by the FringeNYC 2010 side letter amendments to the AEA Basic Showcase Code.
